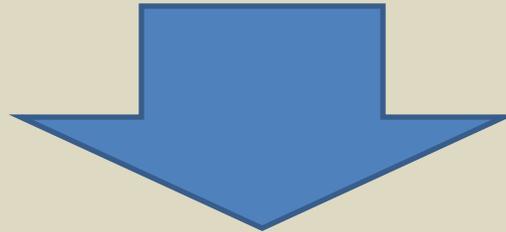

College and Career Readiness Standards Implementation

- Integration of College and Career Readiness Standards (CCRS) into the curriculum
- Align Instructional Materials
- Implementation of on-going Professional Development in CRRS including participation in the Maryland College and Career Readiness Standards conferences
- Development of new student assessments underway

Student Information System (SIS)

- Supported by funding from the Maryland's State Longitudinal Data System Grant (SLDS)
- Implementation of a Commercial-Off-The-Shelf (COTS) SIS for JSE data collection
- Expanded data collections of the SLDS systems
- Implementation scheduled for July 1





Importance of SIS for JSE

- Allows all JSE sites to share student records
- Allows JSE to efficiently transfer students records to local school systems-SR 3 and SR 7
- Allows JSE the ability to analyze and review student achievement data
- Streamlines JSE's student data in an electronic information system comparable to those used within local school systems across the State
- Allows JSE the ability to review student data over time to inform policy and budgetary decision-making



2014 GED Assessment Site

- The American Council on Education and Pearson Vue partner to deliver computer based testing effective January 2014
- Contract between Pearson Vue and MSDE/JSE for test administration finalized
- Assessment site room established at Hickey
- JSE Examiner for GED testing selected and trained
- JSE students testing begins-May 2014



JSE Accountability Overview

Accountability standards:

- **provide performance measures by which JSE ensures excellence, equity, and efficiency through continuous school improvement based upon student achievement**
- **support development of Student Learning Objectives (SLOs)**
- **provide performance data to inform teacher/principal evaluation process**



Current JSE Accountability Standards

Data Based Area	Satisfactory	Excellent
Attendance	94%	96%
GED Pass Rate	60%	70%
Academic Gains-Reading	60% of students will demonstrate a minimum of two months gain between pre-post test scores	70% of students will demonstrate a minimum of two months gain between pre-post test scores
Academic Gains-Math	60% of students will demonstrate a minimum of two months gain between pre-post test scores	70% of students will demonstrate a minimum of two months gain between pre-post test scores



Additional Standards FY 16 (Proposed)

New data-areas:

- CTE and Core Content credits awarded towards a high school diploma
- GED subject area tests successfully passed
- CTE industry certifications obtained



Students Earning Credit

Objective: To increase the number of credits earned

Definition:

Numerator = Total number of students earning 4 or more credits

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Denominator = Total number of students enrolled a minimum of 90 days



GED Subject Test Pass Rate

Objective: To increase student achievement on GED subject tests

Definition:

Numerator = Total number of individual GED subject tests successfully passed during a fiscal year

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Denominator = Total number of individual GED subject tests administered during the fiscal year



Industry Certification Pass Rate

Objective: To increase the number of industry certifications earned by students

Definition:

Numerator = Number of industry certifications (IC) obtained during the fiscal year

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Denominator = Total number of students completing and IC program during the fiscal year
